Spectrum Covid-19 Measures

From 23rd July 2021

Spectrum is open and is following advice from the Market Research Society (MRS) and the Department of Business Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS)

Our commitment is to provide a Viewing Facility that inspires creativity and also provides the comfort and reassurance that these times ask for.

MRS guidance requires that all participants are screened for Covid-19 symptoms or exposure before attending our facility.

Spectrum team will continue to self test every 2 days and do a temperature check daily on arrival.

Spectrum team will continue to wear masks.

Covid-19 signage including Track and Trace notice will remain in place as a reminder to distance where possible.

Spectrum team will continue with our Covid-19 cleaning procedures. This includes but not limited to ventilation of room, sanitising of high touch areas, single use stationary, provision of masks/gloves where required, provision of hand sanitising stations, provision of cleaning supplies in all rooms and protective screen at reception desk.

Spectrum will continue to suggest masks are worn in close contact areas such as reception or any other communal area.

Snacks, sandwiches and drinks will be individually packaged. Takeaway will continue to be delivered in normal fashion.

There is no requirement to wear masks during sessions and seating should be as far apart as capacities allow.

MRS guidance has suggested all payments are made online rather than cash but gloves will be worn when handling incentives.
